The Raglan Art Awards have been revamped this year and the prize categories changed. The theme for the competition is "PIVOT" and art works will be judged by the artist's response to this theme.

The 3 major Prizes are:

Youth Prizes – Any Medium

Raglan Art Award First Prize: \$2500 any medium Secondary School \$200

Raglan Art Award Second Prize: \$1500 any medium Primary School \$100

Raglan Art Award Third Prize: \$700 any medium

Diana Klima Prize: \$250 – best Watercolour *sponsored by the Klima Family*

- The intent of the Art Prize and Exhibition is the showcasing of ***New Work in any medium***, commenced and completed within the period of 24 months of the Raglan Art Awards 2021 (i.e commenced after April 2019).
- Entry forms must reach the Gallery by Wednesday 28th April 2021. Entries received after this date will not be accepted.

Conditions of Entry

- Entries are limited to 2 works per artist. Art works can be in any medium.
- Maximum size of each entry (including frame) 130cm x 100cm. This is the complete work no matter how many pieces.
- All entries must be the original, new unaided work of the artist and not be produced in a structured workshop.
- Entries must not previously have been awarded a prize in an exhibition or show.
- Artwork must be clearly and securely labelled and tagged showing artist's name, title of the work, medium and price and delivered ready to hang fitted with D rings, wire or cord.
- The Raglan Board reserves the right to refuse to hang work deemed not suitable for display.
- The judge's decision will be final, and no discussion will be entered into.
- All entries must be available for sale. Please write the sale price on your entry form and on painting labels/tags. The Raglan commission is 25% for members or 30% for non-members from the sale price.
- The ***non refundable*** entry fee is \$30 for each work entered and \$20 for each entry in the youth section.
- Insurance of the entries is the responsibility of the exhibitor. All care will be taken but no responsibility assumed for damage, loss or theft.
- It is the responsibility of the artist to collect their painting after the event (if not sold) or pay for postage.

IMPORTANT DATES

- Completed entry forms must be received by 3.30pm Wednesday 28th April.
- Artwork delivered by Monday 10th May.
- Judging – Friday 14th May.
- Opening – 3pm Saturday 15th May - all invited.
- Exhibition closes and work to be picked up on either Sunday 20th Monday 21st or Tuesday 22nd June.
